Flagship Projects

In 2025, Barakah Charity implemented several high-impact flagship projects that represent major milestones in our journey of community development. These projects focus on long-term transformation through education and healthcare infrastructure, benefiting present and future generations.

1. Construction of 3-Storey School Buildings.

- Kinniya Girls' School.
- Al-Hira Girls' School.

2. Renovation & Equipment Upgrade – Kinniya Base Hospital

- Including dialysis machine handling-over.

3. Opening of Barakah Center (July 2025)

- A hub for community support and humanitarian activities.

Impact

These projects strengthened education and healthcare infrastructure, improved access to essential services, and contributed to sustainable community development across Sri Lanka.



Program Implementation

Water, Sanitation & WASH Programme

Barakah Charity continued to prioritize access to safe water and sanitation facilities, especially in underserved and rural communities.

- Construction of 18 Water Tank Projects.
- Construction of 250 Small Wells with Electric Motors.
- Implementation of WASH & sanitation projects.
- Construction of 2 school lavatories.
- Distribution of hygiene packages to vulnerable families.

Impact

These projects improved access to clean water, enhanced hygiene practices, reduced waterborne diseases, and created a healthier environment for schools and communities.



Education & Child Development Programme

Education remained a core focus area, with strong emphasis on infrastructure, learning resources, and financial support for students from low-income families.

- Construction of **school classrooms and provision of furniture.** (including Al Nooriya School, Al Furkan School)
- Construction of an **IT Center at Muthur School.** (Al Hussainiya School)
- Construction of **Auditorium project** at school. (Al Hamra school)
- Free eye testing and **Spectacle Distribution** programme
- Provision of **20 desktop computers** for schools.
- Construction of **3-storied school buildings:**
 - Kinniya Girls' School
 - Al-Hira Girls' School
- Renovation of the **library at Kantale.**
- Distribution of **school bags, uniforms, and school furniture.**
- Scholarship support:
 - 60 students (January – June)
 - 100 students (July – December)

Impact

These initiatives enhanced learning environments, reduced school dropout risks, and supported students to continue their education with dignity and confidence.



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Healthcare & Nutrition Support Programme

Barakah Charity strengthened healthcare services and addressed food insecurity through targeted health and nutrition initiatives.

- **Renovation and equipment upgrade for *Kinniya Base Hospital*.**
- **Dialysis Machine Handover.**
- **Distribution of hot meals for needy individuals.**
- **Barakah Friday Hot Meals Programme, with hot meals distributed every Friday across Kinniya.**
- **Opening of the Barakah Centre in July 2025, serving as a hub for community support, nutrition programmes, and charitable activities.**

Impact

Improved healthcare infrastructure, regular nutritional support, and the establishment of the Barakah Centre significantly enhanced access to essential services for vulnerable individuals and communities



Emergency Relief & Food Assistance Programme

In response to emergencies and ongoing economic hardship, Barakah Charity delivered timely relief to affected communities.

- **Flood relief operations**, including hygiene pack and hot meals distribution.
- **Distribution of food packages.**

Impact

These interventions provided immediate relief to disaster-affected and economically vulnerable families, ensuring food security during critical periods.



Livelihood & Community Empowerment Programme

To promote self-reliance and sustainable livelihoods, Barakah Charity supported income-generating activities for vulnerable groups.

- Distribution of canoes (boats) and fishing equipment.
- Distribution of sprayers to farmers.
- Support for Garment and IT Centers.

Impact

These initiatives helped families restore and strengthen their livelihoods, particularly among fishing and farming communities.



Religious & Seasonal Assistance Programme

Seasonal and religious-based projects were implemented to support spiritual well-being and community solidarity.

- Ramadan Projects- (*Iftar, Food Pack, Zakat Fitr, Zakat Fund, Eid Gift*)
- Arafa Iftar Project
- Eid Al-Adha Qurbani Project – distribution from 500 COWS

Impact

These programmes ensured meaningful participation in religious observances while providing food and support to thousands of vulnerable families.

Our work spanned both urban centers and remote rural locations to ensure inclusive access to aid and development.

Future Direction - 2026

In line with its commitment to sustainable development, Barakah Charity plans to expand its impact through key initiatives scheduled for **July 2026** and beyond.

- Opening of the 3-storied building at Kinniya Girls' School
- Opening of the auditorium at Al Hamra Boys' School
- Opening of new classroom facilities in four schools:
 - Al Thaj School – Thoppur
 - An-Noor School – Selvenagar
 - As-Salma School – Thoppur
 - As-Shafa School – Kinniya
- Establishment of new IT Centers in selected schools
- Supply of essential medical equipment to hospitals in need

These initiatives aim to strengthen education and healthcare systems while promoting equal access to opportunities for underserved communities.
